NYU's teacher training changed everything. As graduate students and teachers under the tutelage of director Pat Hoy, we learned how to think about our thinking. We learned ways to unpack our ideas about what we wanted our students to learn and practice, and then how to pair our ideas with techniques for teaching them not only how to do it but also how to talk (to themselves and to each other) about how they were doing it. The experiences in that program and with my students were so energizing that they compelled me to teach writing for more than a decade.

In my beginning as well as intermediate classes, I've asked students to find, read and incorporate peer-reviewed authors and articles (related to their majors or to their hobbies) so they can acclimate to some of the issues, styles and purposes of writing within different professional fields. This does not have to be boring at all! Additionally, I hate that most professors do their students a disservice by postponing these responsibilities. Students aren't infants and it is wrong to treat them as if they are. Morally, we owe students the opportunity to see samples that they will be asked to emulate. They need to practice evaluating and writing about these samples, so the expectations aren't a mystery and so students don't struggle to produce work only to have it ravaged by capricious and arbitrary professors who don't actually tell students what's expected from their papers (I urge students to always ask to see sample

papers in any major or class).

In my introductory and intermediate classes, I've required that we all learn and practice using MLA style citations, with an eye toward learning other citation systems that are standard in different fields or careers. I assign students to research and give class presentations on rhetorical fallacies to introduce each other to some of the strategies and pitfalls of discourse. This has always been an empowering and popular assignment.

Finally, my courses have always included assignment progressions which lead to completed essays about film. I'm so grateful to Alfie Guy at NYU for this idea and methods for getting writers to generate strong prose. The film essay assignments have always been popular and have resulted in some of the most engaging, thoughtful and muscular writing my students achieve during our time together. In a series of writing projects, I ask them to incorporate some common film glossary terms using active language, while describing how a film (whichever each student chooses to write about) presents its subject matter, theme or characters.

I also ask students to find and read a few professional film reviewers to then analyze their strategies and audiences, plus to read a professional or technical paper or two about a topic or problem presented in the film. The goals and results of this writing progression underscore that writers can be professional and poetic at the same time. It's my favorite teaching series, ever, because it asks students for such a great blend of scholarly acknowledgement of other's views along with their personal reflection about meaning and value related to how films present what they present. Many students have told me it's been their favorite essay assignment ever.

McGREW STUDIOS' STUDENT INTERNS

My shop, McGrew Studios, has hosted 29 interns from the SLCC Fashion Institute and more than 39 interns from other area high schools and universities between 2007 and 2024.

This relationship with the Fashion Institute at Salt Lake Community College and other area institutions have allowed us to give students challenging, real-world patternmaking, stitching and fabrication projects that require all of their training and innovative abilities. Our long association with the Fashion Institute directly enhances the creative services that McGrew Studios can offer our public, especially when particular students work with us. Some of our high school interns, by recommendation from their school counselors, have fulfilled their high school's Career & Technical Education requirement by interning. Others self-select in finding their way to us. We've overhired or subcontracted numerous artists, stitchers and costume technicians from this pool. Occasionally, and upon referral, we have accepted students who were not officially seeking internship credits through their school program.

I still host interns in my shop, although now that it's 30 miles away from Salt Lake City it is not as easily accessible for SLCC students. The door is still open, however, and Maria Skelton, the interns advisor on campus, often calls to ask me if she can refer new students my way. Recently, I hired four student costume technicians from Weber State's Department of Performing Arts to work with me on recreating character costumes for AppleTV's reboot of the famous YoGabbaGabba series!
